

Honour before Honours is a student leadership award to encourage independence, creative thinking and interdisciplinary learning.

What does it involve?

Each level has 12 criteria to be achieved, 2 of which you have to design yourself. Tasks include organising a charity event, being involved in a school club or collecting outstanding work. You are responsible for collating evidence, collecting verification and deciding when you are going to do each activity.

Who can apply?

Gifted, talented and abler girls will be invited to apply but it is open to everyone, as long as you submit an application form and it is approved.

How long will it take to achieve?

It depends on you, but months rather than weeks!
